## Our Sewing Centers

From a humble genesis with a global vision, ETR's sewing centers have empowered young woman by teaching them valuable skills, allowing them to become certified, sought after employees within their own communities. In addition, each woman has been emotionally supported, prayed over and encouraged in her own spiritual journey. Our goal is that she will become a spiritual leader within her own home, and in her community. When ETR first decided to expand, we had four sewing centers; one in Pakistan, one in India, and two in Liberia. Building on the successes of our original centers, we have developed a duplicatable curriculum and business plan. During 2023 we have added 11 new sewing centers - Pakistan, India, Liberia, Tanzania, Sierra Leone and we have acquired one center in Uganda. Our current goal is to add seven more centers before the end of 2023.

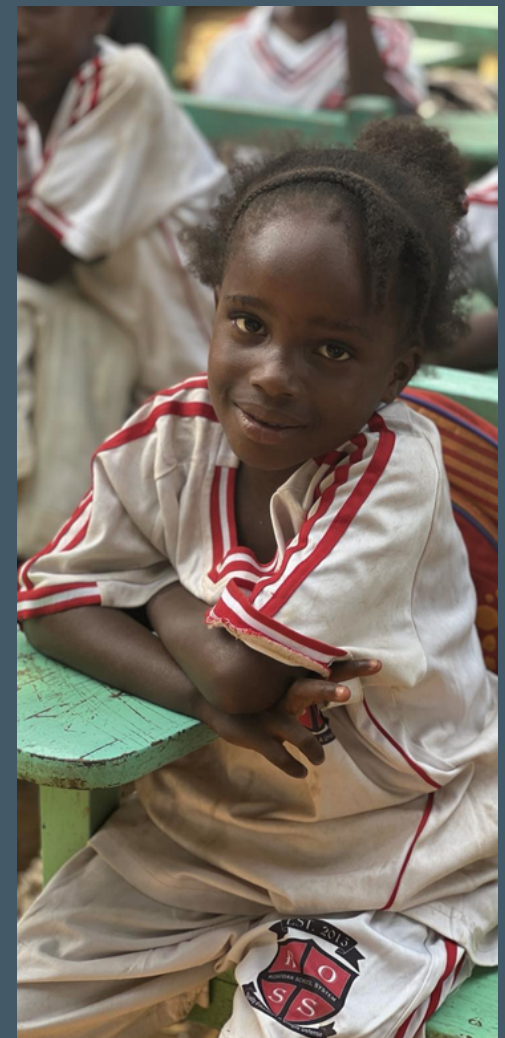
